This result had been achieved by given student homework (practical example of real project) and by teaching weak students again by giving them extra time during office hours. 	 The percentage of progress corresponding to oral communication delivery (64%) and the ability to establish a group discussions and interviews (62%) is less than the average percentage of progress (74%). This weakness is attributed to the weak level English of some students. Also not enough of time is allowed by students to read books and references during break time (library) or at home.
